Match Report

Isis are off the mark, following a resounding 119 run victory against Islip on Sunday. The game is marked not only for the win, but for this being the very first game at Eynesham, our new home from home for the 2017 season. And what a venue it is, a beautifully finished and well equipped clubhouse (including bar!), with a flat field and well-prepared and firm track. And in Eynesham Chairman Ian Miller, we had the perfect host too. And so, despite an easy win, it was a thoroughly enjoyable afternoon.

And so, what of the cricket. Well, Isis won a good toss and elected to bat and openers Rich Stephenson (78) and Olly Walter (17) put 53 on the board, before the latter missed his pull shot and was plum LBW. There were fears of a collapse when two more wickets fell quickly, but Ravi Kella (35) steadied the ship and together with Stephenson a nice partnership saw Isis into three figures. But Islip then brought on secret weapon Goodfellow, who leaked 28 runs off 14 balls before he picked up the wicket of Stephenson and then bowled 20 more balls taking 6 more wickets for just 6 runs. 7 wickets from less than six overs for 34 runs. Bizarre. Without taking anything away from the bowler, his pace and spin definitely confounding the batsmen, but some pretty ordinary batting did help his success. And so, where once a big score looked on, Isis were reduced to 165 all out. But compared to the depths of last week, this score was a massive improvement. Whiter (6-2-12-2) and Wyatt (6-4-4-3) led the Isis defence, helped by a couple of very good catches from Kella and some great fielding from debutant Eddy Hyde. Naveen Sankaravel struggled with his length in his first over as the change bowler, but then recovered to bowl very nicely and pick up a brace. Mo Naqvi got one to nip back for his wicket, and Harry Stoneman joined the party having the Islip top scorer caught from his second ball to end the innings into the 22nd over.
