Back at Queens for our fourth foray of the season, this one against Bodleian library. A beautiful sunny day with a refreshing breeze greeted the players as Bodleian were sent in to bat by Captain Dave. Whiter and Symons led the attack and bowled economically for a wicket a piece, and the librarians were 2 for 38 after 16 overs. Ponsford and East were the change bowlers, and the senior statesman was immediately successful, picking up 3 wickets in his first two overs. The junior statesman served up pies and at drinks the visitors had moved on to 74 for 5. After drinks, East got his length and line together the runs started to dry up and the Bodleian shot selection turned to that of a pub side. Ponsford picked up another brace for Isis's first 5-for of the season (6-0-18-5), before Sankaravel replaced him and East swapped ends. Similar to last week, Naveen started badly but improved length and line to snaffle a couple of late wickets, and East was rewarded for perseverance with a wicket of his own. All out for 110. After tea, the Captain rightly chose an order that got everybody into the game, but the plan nearly back-fired when the top 3 fell cheaply and Isis fell behind a pretty low run-rate. However, Harden (21), Jacobs (30) and Penhallurick himself (40\*) played well and in partnerships to see Isis home, albeit at times at a pedestrian pace and it was into the 37<sup>th</sup> over when they past the post.
