### Match Report

In a modern day rarity, the timed game, Isis held their nerve in a tense finish to win a nice match by 2 wickets. Winning the toss, Isis put the visitors in to bat, and Whiter and Wyatt opened the attack with a nagging length and line that kept the home run rate low. Both bowlers struck in their 5<sup>th</sup> overs and when Wyatt trapped his second LBW in the next, Kempford were struggling at 34 for 3. Sankaravel entered the fray, and got a dirty wicket with a double-bouncer to dismiss the unlucky Caswell. But while Ponsford bowled a tight spell at the other end, he went on to bowl much better and landed a 5-for assisted by catches from Alex Bevan and Nick Wyatt. Catch of the match goes to Kieron Malcolm though, who took a snorter at mid-wicket from Joe Walter's bowling. While not bowling badly, the big hitting Axelberg at number 11 took a liking to the young man's bowling, before Wyatt returned at the death to take the final wicket putting Kempford all out for 143. After tea it took a little while for the red mist to clear from Ravi Kella's eyes, and having survived two dropped catches he went on to play nicely, supported by the dependable Alex Bevan (17), who fell with the score on 39 to a very good catch at mid-on. Debutants Robby Varghese and Devi Rakshith struggled and were gone 13 runs later, before Wiblin steadied the ship batting at 5. Isis were in the 80s at drinks, before the red mist fell again, and having done all the hard work to get Isis within 60 with 20 overs to go, Kella (37) started to charge the bowling and lost his wicket to a sharp stumping. After Walter was bowled cheaply, Whiter and Wiblin combined nicely for a 25-run partnership before the Chair played on, and nerves were jangling with 20 runs needed. A helpful 10 runs then came from no balls and wides to relieve the pressure, and Wyatt and Wiblin continued to nurdle the ball around to get the scores level before Wiblin (26) was caught to create a bit of late drama. But the Captain saw us home and Isis passed the post with a few overs to go.
