Match Report

Isis continued a rich vein of current form to (at last) beat Far From The MCC for the first time since September 2014 in this 35-over contest. Losing the toss on a sun-drenched afternoon, Isis were sent into the field and from the outset they contained the visitor's normally free-flowing scoring with a good all-around bowling and fielding display, marked for a hat-trick of catches by stand-in wicket-keeper Ravi Kella. Keith Whiter (7-3-7-2) had the dangerous Turner and Emmerson back in the pavilion early doors, and the visitor's score was limping along until the left-handed Ainsworth and Ian Howarth shored things up. These two started to really turn things around with a partnership in the 80's, before Howarth holed out driving deep and long to the mid-on boundary, where Wyatt took a very good catch from the bowling of Alan East. A tight spell from Kieron Malcolm (5-0-15-0) preceded the arrival of Dom Henry (4-2-7-4) to the scene, who bowled a treble-wicket maiden to open his account and spark a serious collapse. Nick Wyatt (6.5-2-16-3) returned at the other end, and the pair combined to clean up the tail, the innings ending on 113 all out. After the tea break, a partnership from Stephenson (28) and Phibbs (15) set Isis on the road to victory, before the explosive middle-order pairing of Henry (23) and new man Steve Cooper (28) smashed the ball around to finish things off with ten overs to spare. Played in excellent spirit throughout, the evening finished with a few beers outside the pavilion, and the joy of a bank-holiday lie in to reflect on a job well done.
