Match Report

10-man Enstone burst the Isis bubble at this rain-interrupted 40-over match. The Captain picked up the other opener, and the only other success went to young Kieron Malcolm, who deservedly picked up his first ever wicket for Isis after a running (really!) catch from Ravi Kella.
