After a first over shocker Joe Walter found some bowling form and with good length and flight to bamboozle the batsmen he helped himself to a cool four wickets. The skipper had contributed a few useful runs earlier, and held two to put himself out in front in the catching table, before coming on at the end of the innings to pick up the final wicket with 14 overs to spare.
