Match Report

On a beautiful evening for cricket Isis, took on Bartlemas at a picture-perfect Queens College. Isis batted first and the dependable opening partnership Olly Walter (30) and Luke Blatchford (7) got off to a steady start. Clearly jinxed by his dad arriving with his camera, Luke holed out in the fourth over. Dave Penhallurick (15) returned from his hamstring injury to make a partnership of 32 before he was bowled in the 10th and he was followed by Walter, caught next over. Suresh Sivalingam (11) played a cameo innings before Alex Bevan (31*) and Paul Jacobs (14*) rotated the strike well to put on 40. Bevan in particular took the game to the visitors, and his haul included a magnificent straight six to the long-on boundary. And so Isis came in with 114 on the board, wondering whether that would be enough against a side who beat Isis twice last season. But the hosts put on a determined fielding display to put Bartlemas under early pressure and emerged victorious by restricting them to 87 at the close. A brace of wickets for Keith Whiter, Naveen Sankaravel and Alan East and one each for Nick Wyatt and Joe Walter highlights a very good bowling combination. But it was great support in the field that helped their success, and in particular the athleticism of gloveman Paul Jacobs, whose low-down diving catch and excellent stumping were instrumental in removing two of the Bartlemas dangermen. Great credit to Sankaravel for hitting his length and line from the off and threatening throughout his spell, and to Joe Walter too, who has taken a bit of tap on occasions this season, but did what he does best and gave the ball good air and a perfect length to finish with the best economy of the group. Bartlemas are a good all-round team, and given this was only their second defeat of the season Isis can be pleased with a fine win and a very satisfying team performance in which everybody contributed.
